Building Fund procedures: Council discussed clarifying expenditures for the newly modified Building Fund vs. the Annual Budget. Unplanned/unbudgeted building related expenses can be applied to the Fund but on-going routine building maintenance should be planned/budgeted and funded by the annual budget. Any expense \$3,000 or larger funded by the Building Fund or the Annual Budget requires council approval prior to proceeding.

Boiler System Flushing: The Property Committee has recommended a thorough servicing/flushing of the building's boiler/heating system which was bid at \$6500. MOTION (DW/JN): Move to approve \$6500 for flushing of the boiler system to be funded from the annual budget contingency fund or the Building Fund (whichever is appropriate at the time). APPROVED.
